2025-2026 REGISTRATION

Note: The information below applies to Rep programming provided by Elgin Thames Minor Hockey. Separate registrations for the AMHA, BMHA and DMHA Local League programs will begin in May/June.

Welcome to the inaugural season of the Elgin Thames Minor Hockey 73's!

STEP 1: Tryout Registration

Registration to try out for the Elgin Thames Minor Hockey 73's (ETMH) is now open through the Hockey Canada Registry (HCR). A link is available on the ETMH website.

- A tryout fee of \$100 is payable at the time of registration and is non-refundable after the first skate.
- All registrants will be offered the opportunity to attend a minimum of 3 skates.
- Tryout schedules will be posted on the ETMH website.
- All players that try out for 'A' and do not make a team will automatically be eligible to try out for 'B' (no additional fee).
- Tryouts for U9 MD-2, U18A, U18B and U21 will take place in the fall and a separate registration process will be announced during the summer.
- Players selected to a Rep team will be provided with a link to complete the full registration for the upcoming season (see 'STEP 2').

Body Checking Clinic

Completion of a Body Checking Clinic is mandatory for all players trying out for U14-U18 teams and players in the U13 division who may AP for a U14 team.

ETMH will host a clinic run by TPH London on the evening of April 14th (in class @ 7:15 followed by on ice @ 8:00). Registration is available through the HCR and the fee to attend is \$50. Contact Jen Coghlin @ jennifercoghlin@hotmail.com for more information.

Eligibility

There are no longer any boundary restrictions in Ontario, so anyone is eligible to try out for an ETMH team. Restrictions regarding team size and composition of local vs. non-local players are outlined in the ETMH 'Tryouts and Team Selection' policy.

STEP 2: Team Registration

Signing with ETMH

Throughout the tryout window, ETMH coaches may extend an invitation to 'sign' with their team. At that time, the player will be provided with information to access HCR and complete their full registration (as acceptance of a position on a team). This will need to be completed in a timely manner, or the offer may be rescinded. Registration will be subject to the terms below.

Registration Fees cover the following costs: Ice time, Referees, Timekeepers, Insurance, OMHA fees, Hockey Canada fees, League fees, Practice Equipment, Administration (website, Game sheets, etc.). In addition to home game times, U10-U18 A and B teams will be allotted 2 (60-minute) practices per week and U9MD and U21 will be allotted 1 practice ice time per week.

Registration Fee Payment Plans

Payments can be made by credit card at the time of registration.

ETMH provides the following payment plans as an option if selected during registration:

Spring Team Selections:

25% at time of registration

25% on June 15th

25% on July 15th

25% on August 15th

Fall Team Selections:

50% at time of registration

50% on October 31st

Any player whose account is not current with the above schedule will not be eligible to participate in any on-ice activities until the required payments are made.

Equipment Fees

In addition to registration fees, players will be required to pay the cost of equipment including jersey's, socks and any other required equipment. Players will be able to reuse purchased equipment in subsequent years assuming appropriate size and condition. Teams may choose to utilize approved fundraising and/or sponsorship opportunities to help offset these costs.

Team Fees

Players may be required to pay a "TEAM FEE" to their team to cover additional costs that will be incurred during the season (on-ice development, dryland training, tournament fees, etc.). Team fees are set, collected and managed by individual teams/coaches, and are separate from registration or equipment fees collected by ETMH. Teams may choose to cover all or a portion of Team Fees through approved Sponsorship and/or Fundraising.

Sponsorship & Fundraising

Subject to board review and approval, team or individual player sponsorships and team fundraisers will be permitted to help offset Team Fees and Equipment costs for players. All fundraisers must be approved by the ETMH board. Please refer to ETMH policies on 'Sponsorship' and 'Fundraising' for additional details.

Refunds

The board and/or its designate will consider refunds on an individual basis upon receiving a written request through the “Request for a Refund” form by the player and the player’s parent(s)/guardian(s) to withdraw from hockey through ETMH. See ETMH policy on ‘Refunds’ for additional details.
